Voluntary Outdoor Watering Restrictions Start April 1

Dear Security Water and Sanitation District Customer:

Security Water District is pleased to inform you that we are continuing to supply all of our customers with 100 percent surface water, free of Perfluorinated Chemicals (PFCs). This water is transported from Pueblo Reservoir and does not contain PFCs. All of Security Water District's groundwater wells continue to be shut down. Tap water is safe to drink and use and there is no need to purchase bottled water.

After being informed that our groundwater wells were impacted from PFCs last winter, Security Water developed a comprehensive plan to ensure we could deliver water to you that continued to meet all federal and state regulations and was PFC free. That plan included voluntary watering restrictions during the summer months and purchasing additional surface water from Colorado Springs Utilities. We also installed new infrastructure that allow us to pipe surface water more readily to all our customers. Our Board of Directors also approved additional infrastructure that will allow us to transport even more treated surface water from Colorado Springs Utilities. The installation of these pipes will be completed this spring.



Since surface water is more expensive than groundwater, we are still looking to the Air Force to advance their plans to treat the groundwater for PFCs. It will be important for our long-term water supply and to manage our water rates that we are able to use our groundwater wells again. We are working hard to advocate for the restoration of our groundwater supply.

We appreciate your ongoing patience with this matter.

While these rules are voluntary, it will be critical that all customers cooperate to ensure we have adequate water to meet our high water demand months.

SECURITY WATER VOLUNTARY OUTDOOR WATERING RESTRICTIONS

- Starting April 1 and extending to October 1, 2017, we are enacting voluntary outdoor watering restrictions. We are asking customers to limit outdoor water to three times per week or less.
- Water during the cooler times of the day – do not water your lawn between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. Avoid overwatering.
- Homes/businesses with addresses ending in even numbers may water on Monday, Wednesday and Saturdays.
- Homes/businesses with addresses ending in odd numbers may water on Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday.
- All customers should avoid watering on Fridays.
