WATER IS FLOWING THROUGH NEW PIPELINE



Please see reverse side for watering schedule Security Water District is pleased to report that it began receiving water through its new pipeline connection with Colorado Springs Utilities on Tuesday, May 16, 2017. With this new pipeline and the short-term water supply agreement that was approved by the Colorado Springs City Council and the Security Water District Board of Directors, we are confident that sufficient supplies are now available to meet all of our customers' water needs. Without this new agreement and pipeline, the District would not have had enough water to meet this summer's peak demands since all wells were shut down last year due to the discovery of trace amounts of Perfluorinated chemicals ("PFCs") in the Widefield Aquifer.

Even with this new pipeline in service, the District still encourages customers to use water wisely and observe the voluntary outdoor watering restrictions which became effective on April 1st (please see reverse side for outdoor watering schedule). The District appreciates the efforts of its customers since April 1st to conserve water until this new water supply came online.



The District's Board of Directors is also very appreciative of the efforts of its staff and consultants, as well as Colorado Springs Utilities, numerous contractors, governmental and regulatory agencies and private property owners that have helped facilitate the construction of this project.

- Please follow this simple watering schedule. Homes/businesses with addresses ending in even numbers may
 water on Monday, Wednesday and Saturdays. Homes/businesses with addresses ending in odd numbers may
 water on Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday. All customers should avoid watering on Fridays.
