

To: Security Water District customers affected by construction activities.

June 17, 2019

As you may know, the infrastructure and engineering firm AECOM, under the direction of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) and the U.S. Air Force (USAF), and through its subcontractors, has begun construction of a state-of-the-art drinking water mitigation facility. This facility is being constructed in order to mitigate historic groundwater contamination and will allow Security to once again utilize its groundwater resources, including 24 wells that have not been used since 2016. This complex project will involve installing more than five miles of pipeline and construction of a centrally-located ion-exchange mitigation facility.

A significant amount of work will be done in Cody Drive over the next few months. The Traffic Plan on the reverse side of this flier provides some preliminary information on the sequencing of this work. Work in the affected areas will be implemented in a manner that minimizes disruption and inconvenience within the vicinity of the work area. Portions of Cody Drive will be closed to through traffic at certain times. However, residents and businesses within the closure area, as well as Pinello Elementary School, will have access at all times that the road is closed. Residents outside of the immediate closure area are encouraged to use alternate routes during times of road closures.

We thank you for your patience and cooperation during this period of construction and apologize for any inconvenience this critical construction activity causes.
